We bought culturally responsive resources.

We purchased CEFR aligned resources to create duotangs for A1 and A2.



What We Learned

That resources are available; however they may need to be simplified or enhanced for the appropriate CEFR level. We have learned that there is no such thing as a perfect resource and that every book we purchased has its own unique benefits and weaknesses.

We learned what is specifically required within each level in terms of vocabulary, grammar, types of questions, etc. We also learned how to modify tasks at the A1 level to prepare students to approach the A2 level.
